

**Information on the protection of individuals
with regard to the processing of personal data
(General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679, art 13)**

The processing of personal data at the Embassy of Italy is based on the principles of lawfulness, fairness and transparency to protect the fundamental rights and freedoms of individuals.

In this regard, the following information is provided:

1. The holder of the treatment (controller) is the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, Republic of Italy, operating, in this specific circumstances, through the Italian Embassy in Stockholm (Djurgårdsvägen 174 115 21 Stockholm , mail info.stockholm@esteri.it; pec: amb.stocolma@cert.esteri.it; tel +46 (0) 854567100).

2. For any questions or complaints, the interested party may contact the Person in Charge of Personal Data Protection (RPD) of MAECI (postal address: Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, Piazzale della Farnesina 1, 00135 ROMA, telephone: 0039 06 36911 (switchboard), mail: rpd@esteri.it; pec: rpd@cert.esteri.it).

3. Personal data collected will be used for invitations to cultural, scientific or convivial events; economic promotion activities; public diplomacy activities; meetings and communications to the community.

4. The processing of data in the database is based on consent. In case of denial of the consent, services and invitations as per point 3) of the present information sheet will not be accessible.

5. The processing of data, carried out by personnel specifically in charge at the Embassy, will be carried out in manual mode.

6. The data provided by the interested party during registration will be processed only by the Embassy and will not be sent to third parties.

7. Every 3 years from the registration or its renewal, the Embassy will ask the users to confirm their interest in the service; in case of a negative reply or of a non-reply by a recipient, his/her personal data will be cancelled.

8. The interested party can request access to his/her personal data and request, if necessary, their correction. Without prejudice to the consequences on access to the service, it may also request the cancellation of such data, as well as the limitation of the treatment or the opposition to their treatment. In these cases, the interested party must submit a specific request to the Embassy of Italy in Stockholm, informing the MAECI RPD.

9. If you believe that your rights have been violated, you can file a complaint with the MAECI RPD.
